9.30 – 12.30 am	<p>Presentation of best practice 1: Superact !</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • speed networking session for project work • Presentation about current teenage parent project in Devon <p>After a friendly welcome our host presented their work and educational offers. Several employees presented aspects and projects of Superact and how they blend arts and music with learning opportunities. E.g. we learned about two bigger projects on national level: Our Big Gig, where Superact organized a national wide event with 326 concerts on local level took place on a single weekend. Another national project is The Last Past, a five-year intergenerational project where communities are brought together to reflect on World War I. Also Superact presented a new project – exclusively for lone parents. It is a regional project, where Superact helps a group of young teenage parents to get back into the labour market, either by finding a job or an apprenticeship or by helping them to make a college degree. Very interesting for all the partners was Superact´s presentation on SEPE: a level 1 accredited qualification developed by Superact. Learners take part in a creativity project and receive a recognition of soft skills which equals a basic level of knowledge in the labour market. Besides that Superact presented their projects in the penal system and health sector, where musicians visit hospitals and homes for the elderly to make music for/with persons in the need of care.</p>

BGE cover a wide range of services: language and skills training, coaching and counselling of unemployed persons, etc. Due to the fact that French-Guyana is mostly rural, many persons have to</p>

Therefore business start-up coaching is an important service and Julien presented a method, how to organise a start-up idea from scratch and how to do this in a understandable and fun way. The method will be included in the final product, the handbook and on the website.
